Our Mission

The John's Island Community Service League is a non-profit, member driven organization primarily involved in raising funds for operating expenses of charitable agencies in Indian River County concerned with the health, education, and human services issues that affect women, children and families in need. Only organizations that do not discriminate on the basis of race, religion or ethnicity will be considered. Scholarship support for post-secondary education is also provided to John's Island Employees and their children.

Our Grant Programs 2020

**This year we awarded \$1,220,330 in grants.
Lifetime grants total \$14,037,197!**

We allocated grants through 4 different groups:

MAIN GRANTS COMMITTEE – 70 Members distributed \$1,048,000 to 38 Agencies. We fund general operating expenses for Agencies who meet our mission. Agencies are screened initially to ensure they meet our mission, are a 501(c)(3) and have audited financials. Then they are permitted to apply to our annual cycle which begins in October and ends in March. Each Agency and program is thoroughly analyzed and all are visited.

MARLYNN SCULLY STRATEGIC GRANTS COMMITTEE –

10 Members allocated \$59,259 to 1 Agency. We fund start-ups, off cycle requests, collaboratives, and multi-agency collaborations. We assess requests year round. Generally, one time funding.

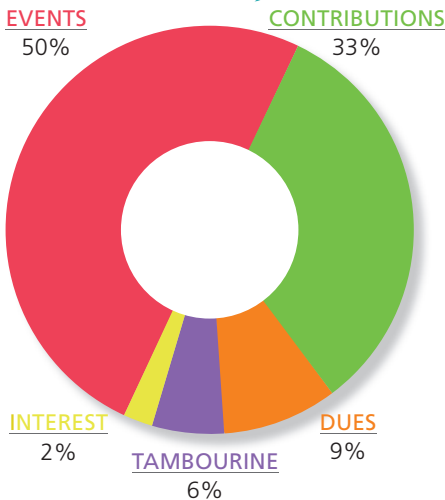
SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE – 1 member allocated \$57,700 to 11 employees and 10 children of employees for Certificate programs and College scholarships.

Grants Awarded 2019–2020 Main Grants Committee

ADULT SENIOR CARE/ADULT EDUCATION

ALZHEIMER & PARKINSON ASSOCIATION

\$45,000 (2020) - \$362,225 (TOTAL since 2007)

Serves community residents with disorders affecting memory and movement. Our grant funds the *Caring for the Caregiver* program which offers caregivers temporary relief and scholarships for Adult Day Care Services.

SENIOR RESOURCE ASSOCIATION & PUBLIC GUARDIANS (Merger 2019)

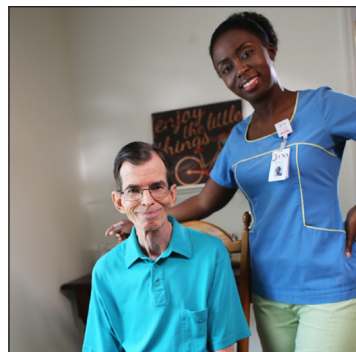
\$55,000 (2020) - \$358,000 (TOTAL since 2004, including grants to Public Guardians)

We support the *Day Away* centers, located in Vero Beach and Sebastian, which provide coordinated health, social and therapeutic activities in a supervised group setting. They serve 133 adults who can no longer be left alone during the day due to functional and/or cognitive impairments. Our grant also supports *Public Guardianship* for persons of low income deemed legally incompetent and without family or friends willing or able to assume the role of guardian. The program alleviates human suffering, reduces long hospital stays and assures effective use of community resources. The merger has allowed additional guardians to be trained, reducing the waiting list.

VISITING NURSE ASSOCIATION

\$30,000 (2020) - \$350,000 (TOTAL since 2000)

Sets the standard for patients and caregivers needing home health, hospice, and community health services. Our grant helps offset the cost of Medicaid-eligible home health care and Medicaid reimbursement to VNA.



SENIOR COLLABORATIVE

\$15,000 (2020) – \$25,00 (TOTAL since 2018) Our grant funds purchase of a database to help Seniors and their families find information and referral to services, both for-profit and not-for-profit that a Senior may need. The project aims to be self-sustaining in the future through the sale of memberships to organizations that serve Seniors.

LITERACY SERVICES

\$25,000 (2020) - \$148,500 (TOTAL since 2006)

The mission is to improve the literacy skills of adults so they will become more productive citizens. Our grant supports volunteer training and the purchase of educational materials.



UNITED AGAINST POVERTY

\$30,000 (2020) - \$243,700 (TOTAL since 2010)

Our grant helps fund *Success Training for Employment Program*. STEP is designed to fill a gap in our community to serve unemployed adults with barriers to employment such as little or no work history, substance abuse and/or mental health, and criminal background issues.

CRISIS/FOSTER CARE

CHILDREN'S HOME SOCIETY

\$20,000 (2020) - \$236,500 (TOTAL since 2000)

We fund the *Transitional Living Program* for young adults ages 18-22 who have aged out of the foster care system and would otherwise be homeless. At any one time, 8-12 are housed and provided a range of supports while they complete high school and prepare for successful independent living.

Grants Awarded 2019–2020 Main Grants Committee

HIBISCUS CHILDREN'S CENTER

\$20,000 (2020) - \$185,000 (TOTAL since 2004)

Our grant helps fund the *Career Pathways to Independence* program provided to foster youth ages 13 - 17 at the Hibiscus Children's Village with wrap-around supports to promote academic success, high school completion, independent living, college, jobs or trades.

SAFE FAMILIES FOR CHILDREN

\$20,000 (2020) – NEW!

A movement fueled by compassion to keep children safe and families intact and out of the foster care system. Children are hosted on a short-term basis through *Volunteer Families*, *Family Friends*, and *Family Coaches* to form a network that helps families in crisis while they get back on their feet.

HOMELESS/HOUSING

HOPE FOR FAMILIES CENTER

\$30,000 (2020) - \$478,000 (TOTAL since 2000)

This center can house 21 homeless families with children under 18. Case managers help parents find employment, develop a budget, save money, move into permanent housing, and enroll children in school. Average stay is 6 months.

SAMARITAN CENTER

\$30,000 (2020) -
\$258,000

(TOTAL since 2009)

Our grant helps provide longer term housing to homeless families. The Center can house 9 families or 26 individuals as it prepares them to live independently.



THE SOURCE

\$35,000 (2020) - \$402,000
(TOTAL since 2008)

Provides hot meals, showers, clothing, hygiene items, food pantry, mail, rental and utility assistance to homeless people who may be living in the woods, in their car, or under the bridge. Can also be used as an emergency overnight shelter.



TREASURE COAST

HOMELESS SERVICES COUNCIL

\$30,000 (2020) - \$499,000 (TOTAL since 2003)

We fund a bridge housing program for 16 disenfranchised single women. With the help of intense counseling and coaching, the women gain the requisite skills to obtain employment and permanent housing.

HEALTH AND WELLNESS

LIFEBUILDERS OF THE TREASURE COAST

\$35,000 (2020) - \$185,000 (TOTAL since 2013)

Low income individuals affected by the court system have financial needs that cannot be met by public funding. *LifeBuilders (LB)* fills that gap and helps these individuals move toward job, family and financial stability. *LB* works with the Public Defender's Office, Sheriff's Office and social services agencies in IRC.

TREASURE COAST COMMUNITY HEALTH

\$35,000 (2020) - \$195,000 (TOTAL since 2013)

Our grant supports their *Woman's Health Fund* which provides mammograms and other preventive screening to those who cannot afford it. Will serve 250 women next year.

Grants Awarded 2019–2020 Main Grants Committee

COUNSELING/MENTAL HEALTH

MENTAL HEALTH ASSOCIATION

\$25,000 (2020) - \$408,000 (TOTAL since 2000)

Our grant supports mental health care for children, teens and their families to address their holistic needs including mental health, social, educational and skill building at the *Walk-In & Counseling Center*. Serves 280 children plus their families.

SUBSTANCE AWARENESS COUNCIL

\$35,000 (2020) - \$410,500 (TOTAL since 2000)

Our grant supports the *Redirect Counseling Program* for children ages 12-18 identified with risky behaviors that could lead to substance abuse. Program motivates adolescents and families to aspire to a substance-free and positive lifestyle. Serves 615 including families.

TYKES & TEENS

\$30,000 (2020) - \$84,000 (Total since 2018)

Our grant helps support the *Alternative to Out of School Suspension* program (ALTOSS) for middle and high school students who have been suspended. JICSL Strategic funds helped start this program in our County in fall 2018 with the objective of reducing the rate of repeat suspensions and drop-outs.

SPECIAL NEEDS

THE ARC

\$40,000 (2020) - \$421,300 (TOTAL since 2000)

The Arc helps 172 adults acquire skills that lead to greater independence, more opportunities to make choices affecting their lives, and to become valued members in the communities where they live. Our grant supports staff training in a field with high staff turnover.

SUNSHINE REHABILITATION CENTER

\$15,000 (2020) - \$40,000 (TOTAL since 2018)

We fund the *Sunshine Kids Support Fund* that covers

the cost of out-patient rehabilitation therapy to 76 under insured children with delayed milestones. Early intervention and aggressive therapy ensures the best possible long-term outcomes.

SPECIAL EQUESTRIANS

\$15,000 (2020) - \$50,325

(TOTAL since 2017)

We fund the *Therapeutic Horseback Riding* program that provides horsemanship instruction to 103 children with disabilities, while using the movement of the horses to achieve physical, cognitive, behavioral, social and psychological benefits. The children have various conditions such as cerebral palsy, stroke, Down Syndrome, spina bifida, learning disabilities, developmental delays, and autism.



YOUTH SAILING FOUNDATION

\$12,000 (2020) - \$22,000 (TOTAL since 2019)

We fund the *Adaptive Sailing Program*. Instructors use 3 specially adapted sailboats to help special needs sailors move from tentativeness to euphoria as they learn to pilot their own boats on the open water, while gaining confidence and self-esteem.

NURTURING CHILDREN

EDUCATION FOUNDATION OF IRC

\$35,000 (2020) - \$373,000

(TOTAL since 2000)

Our funds support the *STEP into Kindergarten Program* - a 6-week prekindergarten extension for 225 struggling PreK completers. Taught by trained teachers in School District classrooms. The goal is to reduce "summer slide" and to improve school readiness.



Grants Awarded 2019–2020 Main Grants Committee

JICSL funds enabled the start-up of this program in 2013. Given COVID, this program is being restructured and did not occur this summer.

E.O.C. HEAD START

\$35,000 (2020) - \$211,000 (TOTAL since 2004)

Our grant funded a new *Early Bird* (EB) program at St. Helen's Head Start Center in Gifford. EB is a free, high-quality early childhood care and education program for at-risk, low-income 3-year-olds focusing on child and family development/success. It joins two other JI launched EB's in South Vero and at Dodgertown Elementary.



HEALTHY START COALITION

\$55,000 (2020) - \$418,000 (TOTAL since 2000)

Healthy Start provides a variety of programs to optimize the health of mothers, children, and families. JICSL currently supports 2 different programs, both of which received JICSL start up grants. They are: *Parents as Teachers* (PAT), a program to promote literacy and school readiness for children 0-3 and the *Doula Program* serving high-risk mothers before, during, and after delivery.

REDLANDS CHRISTIAN MIGRANT ASSOCIATION (NOW RCMA)

\$30,000 (2020) - \$115,000 (TOTAL since 2016)

RCMA operates 3 childcare centers in low income areas of IRC serving birth to age 5. Our grant funds a part time volunteer coordinator for these sites which serve 257 children.



KINDERGARTEN
READINESS COLLABORATIVE
\$30,000 plus \$5,000 Merger
Bonus (2020) - \$95,575
(TOTAL since 2016)

Our grant supports KRC's community-based *Family Connection Centers* in Fellsmere and Gifford and includes a bonus heralding their merger with The Learning Alliance. Family Engagement Specialists increase awareness and make referrals to existing resources of 15 partner agencies, demonstrate age-appropriate activities, share basic child development information, encourage preschool and VPK attendance, support early identification of special needs and help parents navigate the service system for 592 children and their families.

EDUCATION AFTER SCHOOL

BOYS & GIRLS CLUB

\$15,000 (2020) - \$242,000 (TOTAL since 2001)

We support the Vero Beach Club after school program which serves 350 at-risk youth. Our grant supports *Project Learn*, designed to develop academic, behavioral and social skills through homework assistance, tutoring and enrichment.

CROSSOVER MISSION

\$25,000 (2020) - \$123,000 (TOTAL since 2016)

We support Crossover's efforts to re-direct 75 "at risk" youth using the love of basketball to motivate athletic and scholastic achievement. Dedicated coaches and volunteer academic mentors are integral to the program's success.

GIFFORD YOUTH ACHIEVEMENT CENTER

\$25,000 (2020) - \$530,500 (TOTAL since 2000)

Our grant supports GYAC's After School Education Program for grades K-12, with certified teachers during the school year providing daily homework assistance, tutoring, educational/cultural enrichment, socialization, and recreation.



Grants Awarded 2019–2020 Main Grants Committee

GIFFORD YOUTH ORCHESTRA
\$10,000 (2020) - \$76,500
(TOTAL since 2008)

The Gifford Youth Orchestra is a prevention/enrichment program which believes that by focusing on music education and performance, it will keep the disadvantaged children of Gifford off the streets. Their motto is "Off the Street and On the Stage."



EDUCATION – OTHER

BIG BROTHERS BIG SISTERS

\$25,000 (2020) - \$238,500 (TOTAL since 2004)

Our grant supports school and site-based reading mentoring programs to 105 4-year-olds in PreK centers and 295 low performing K-3rd grade students. Screened and trained volunteers mentor children one-on-one during school hours.

THE LEARNING ALLIANCE

\$35,000 plus \$5,000 Merger Bonus (2020) - \$276,110
(TOTAL since 2011)

We fund the *Moonshot Academy* after school program on 4 elementary school campuses. The 8-week fall program serves 160 rising second and third grade students falling below the 50th percentile based on iReady scores. It will be in session 3 days a week, 2 hours per day. The goal is to catch struggling students up to their peers and help them make progress in their literacy skills. Grant includes a bonus heralding the merger with Kindergarten Readiness Collaborative.

ORCA (OCEAN RESEARCH AND CONSERVATION ASS.)

\$15,500- NEW!

"*Lagoon Guardians*," offers a unique afterschool and summer science program. 80 middle



school students study *STREAM* subjects that relate specifically to the conservation of our lagoon, its waters, and surrounding eco-systems. They do real scientific work assisting senior scientists, collecting samples, and analyzing them under a microscope in a professional lab.



PELICAN ISLAND AUDUBON INSTITUTE

\$15,000 (2020) plus \$5,000 for an audit - NEW!

The Pelican "*Lagoon Advocates Program*" teaches 104 economically disadvantaged 5th graders to use scientific methods to record results in journals, inspiring them to love and respect our natural surroundings. This natural sciences program exposes the students to Audubon's mission: to preserve and protect animals, birds, plants, and our precious land and water for future generations.

WILLIS SPORTS BASEBALL ACADEMY

\$10,000 (2020) – NEW!

Willis Sports serves 240 underrepresented and disadvantaged children and youth ages 2 – 18. The after school and summer programs fuse academics (taught by accredited teachers) along with baseball and take place at historic Dodgertown, as well as several nearby elementary schools. We fund *Fun at Bat* (supported by Major League Baseball), for 60 elementary school kids.



YOUTH GUIDANCE MENTORING & ACTIVITIES PROGRAM

\$17,000 (2020) - \$166,000 (TOTAL since 2008)

Our grant is supporting the *STEAM Magnet* component of the *Mentoring Academy*. The Academy currently operates 12-15 different activity groups every 8 weeks, 6 times a year for 210 children. The *STEAM* program is offered 5 times a year. Students come from low income, single parent homes.

Awarded for Scholarship. Strategic and Contingency Funds

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

TAKE STOCK IN CHILDREN:

INDIAN RIVER STATE COLLEGE FOUNDATION

\$28,500 (2020) - \$294,950 (TOTAL since 2001)

Since 2001, the JICSL has funded scholarships to 37 low Income students to attend Indian River State College.



Eighth graders apply to this program. They are mentored throughout high school, provided they have good grades and remain drug and crime

free. Following graduation, their college tuition is paid to cover a 4-year college degree. Often they are the first generation in their family to earn this honor.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR JOHN'S ISLAND EMPLOYEES AND THEIR CHILDREN

\$57,700 (2020) - \$625,809 (TOTAL since 1999)

Since 1999, we have awarded college scholarships to

children of JI employees. In 2019 we began a program in coordination with Indian River State College to pay for tenured and GPA eligible full time JI employees to pursue a degree or certificate program.

MARLYNN SCULLY STRATEGIC FUND

EARLY LEARNING COALITION

\$59,259 (2020)

Funds were used to purchase a curriculum and materials and to train teachers in 16 4-year-old PreK classrooms. The curriculum has a 3-5 year life and will improve consistency across multiple PreK Centers.

CONTINGENCY FUND

UNITED WAY COVID-19 FUND

\$50,000 Out of Contingency Fund

In April, we contributed, along with other funding groups, to the *United Way COVID-19 Fund* to assist local Agencies help vulnerable people affected by this unprecedented crisis.

Subsequent Grant Events – COVID-19 \$350,000 in Grants

“An early Easter can mean the difference between making ends meet, or not for a family.”

Indian River County's largest pool of employees are in the hospitality and service industries, so when Easter arrives early and the “snow birds” leave town, local incomes takes a hit. Just imagine what happened when COVID shut down these and other industries the second week in March (five weeks before Easter)! By April 2020, unemployment in IRC was up to 14% (vs. 3.5% April 2019). Suddenly, thousands of residents were out of work and unable to buy food or pay rent.

Non-profit funders in IRC, including JICSL, quickly rallied to establish a fund, managed by United Way of IRC, dedicated to COVID-19 assistance. The UW was the logical place to manage this. A testament to excellent collaboration amongst the funders, the UW COVID-19 Fund raised \$1,440,000 and grant making began at the end of March. The JICSL contributed \$250,000 to the Fund, \$200,000 of which was earmarked as a matching grant in May to help raise an additional \$200,000. Most has been spent as of this writing and what remains is earmarked for childcare subsidies. The UW COVID-19 Fund disbursements have gone to the following areas: rent/utilities, food supports, child care subsidies, diapers/formula/hygiene and prescriptions.

The County has recently been allotted CARES Act and SHIP (Florida Housing) money. These monies will help provide additional funds for rental and mortgage assistance, as well as food. This will provide much needed additional resources once the UW COVID-19 Fund is depleted.

In addition to providing direct support through the UW Covid-19 Fund, the JICSL pledged \$150,000 to support a new program we call HEART -- Housing Emergency Advocacy Response Team. HEART is a collaboration between Florida Rural Legal Services (FRLS), the Indian River County Bar Association (IRCBA) and JICSL.



HEART began with the notion that residents experiencing COVID-related unemployment or underemployment would need pro bono legal assistance to avoid eviction or foreclosure when they are no longer able to make their payments. We turned to FRLS to house a new attorney position dedicated to IRC and provide program support, including collaborating with the IRC Bar Association for additional pro bono assistance. Launched in late summer, the HEART program is now providing IRC clients with counseling, mediation and advocacy with landlords and lenders, negotiating lease and mortgage modifications, and making court appearances, as necessary to avoid eviction. The JICSL funding will support this program for the next year.

Iola Mosley was hired by FRLS to oversee the HEART program in IRC. She has a BA and JD from Howard University and brings a high level of experience, knowledge, and passion to this initiative. You will have a chance to meet Ms. Mosely and get an update on the program later in the year, when she will appear as the guest speaker at a Community Conversations Forum on December 14th.

We are constantly evaluating where the gaps in coverage are in our community, and cannot thank you enough for making it possible to be able to support our neighbors in need at this time!

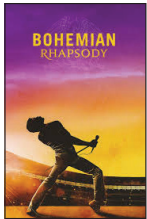

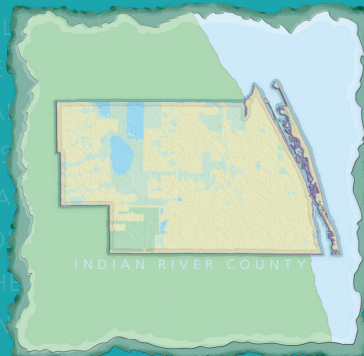
